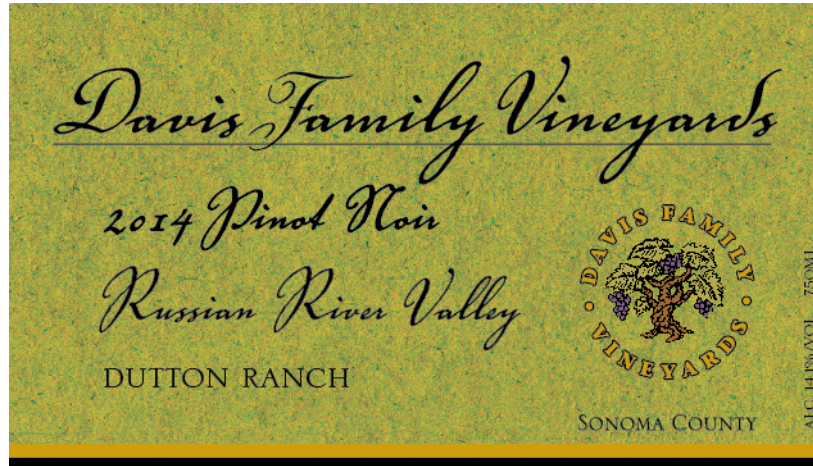


Davis Family Vineyards

2014 Pinot Noir, Dutton Ranch Russian River Valley



The fermentations of this Pinot Noir were conducted using only native yeast. This wine spent 14 months in tight grain selections of French Oak, and in this vintage the oak was a combination of 30% new, 30% 1 year-old and 30% 2-year old barrels. Gentle punch downs were done over a 3-4 week fermentation, after a 5-7 day cold soak, - all in small, temperature controlled, open top fermentors. The wines all went from fermentor directly into barrel by gravity flow.

This Green Valley expression of Pinot Noir is grown for us by the Dutton family, cornerstone growers in the Russian River Valley. Two neighboring blocks of Pommard and Dijon clones, half way between the coastline and our own Estate Soul Patch Vineyard, nestled on a slope directly east of the Russian River's transition to the Ocean. This is one of the coolest climate sites in the Russian River Valley – creating mouthwatering acidity, exotic aromas, and a complex fruit profile centered around the signature blueberry notes Green Valley is known for.
